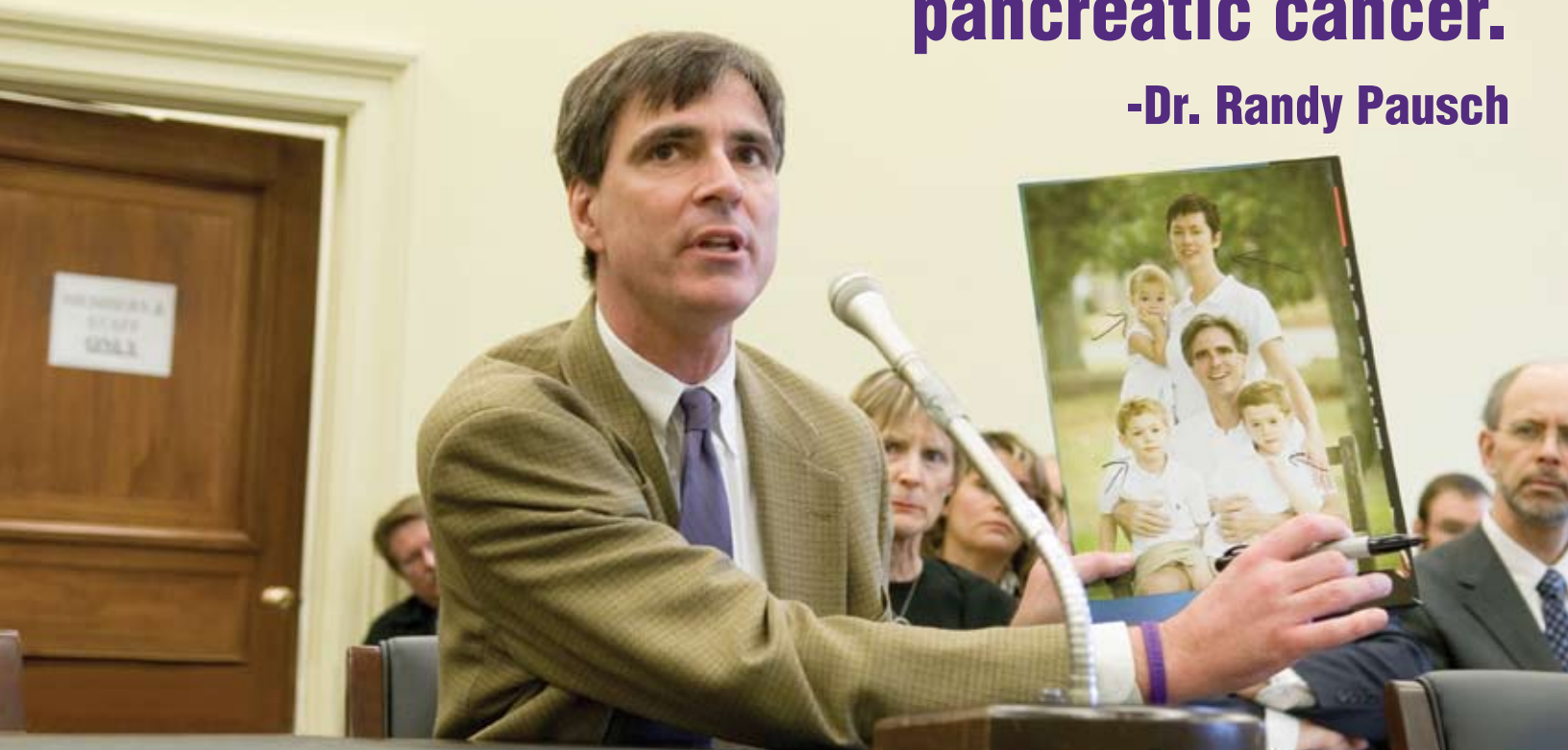


Every day matters in the fight against pancreatic cancer.
